In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 48 of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 (Central Act 52 of 1984) read with Rule 27 & 28 of the Kerala State Veterinary Council Rules, 1991, the Government of Kerala hereby direct that for the renewal of registration of Registered Veterinary Doctors included in the Kerala State Veterinary Register, whose registration needs to be renewed before the first day of the April of



the year to which it relates, shall pay a renewal fee of Rs. 15/- (Rupees Fifteen only) for every five years. If the registration is not renewed within the stipulated time limit it shall be considered as a default and the defaulter shall be removed from the Kerala State Veterinary Register.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form the part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Registrar of Kerala State Veterinary Council has reported that many Registered Kerala State Veterinary Practitioners had not renewed their registration as per the provisions of Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 and proposed to allow them to renew and for the retention of their name in the Kerala State Veterinary Register. The Government examined the matter in detail and decided to issue a notification for allowing them to renew the registration by paying Rs.15/- for every five years and in default for the removal of the defaulters name from the Kerala State Veterinary Register.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
